### 1. Remove Roof Rack Leg Covers

(a) Remove the rear right roof rack leg cover.

Using the nylon removal tool along the inner edge, pull up and forward on cover (Fig 1-1)

(b) Repeat the removal for the rear left side.Discard both leg covers.

NOTE: At re-assembly, replace the roof rack leg covers with new covers noted on "Vehicle Service Parts" on page 1.

# 2. Crossbar Installation

- (a) Loosen the knobs on each crossbar joint. (Fig. 2-1)
- (b) Ensuring that the arrow on the crossbar joint is facing toward the front of the vehicle, slide crossbar joints into left and right roof channels. The front and rear crossbar should be more than 100mm from the front and rear channel ends. Do not tighten the knobs. (Fig. 2-2)

NOTE: Wind noise may be generated if the crossbars are installed with the arrow pointing rearward.









# 3. Roof Rack Leg Cover Installation

- (a) Position the tab at the front of the right rear cover into the guide on the leg. Then align rear clip. (Fig. 3-1)
  - (b) Press outer clip to engage to leg.
  - (c) Press inner clip to engage to leg.
  - (d) Snap inner tabs
  - (e) Repeat for the left rear cover.
  - (f) Confirm that the cover is installed securely.

# 4. Install Stoppers

(a) Install the stoppers against the leg covers at the front and rear by pressing the stopper into the groove. (Fig. 4-1)

# 5. Crossbar Alignment

- (a) Position front and rear crossbars so that they are touching the stoppers at the front and rear leg cover. (Fig. 5-1)
- (b) Crossbars should be parallel A=A'; B=B'from the rear end of the vehicle. (Fig. 5-2)
- (c) Securely tighten the knobs.
