

(a) Open the rear cargo door and locate the panel shown on the passenger's side of the vehicle.






(b) Remove and discard panel cover with a trim panel removal tool. (Fig. 1-1)

(c) Remove and retain the screw using a 10mm socket and driver.(Fig. 1-2)













2. Installation of Cargo Net

(a) Orient the net so the pull-tab is facing towards the rear of the vehicle and install the bottom hook over the passenger side lower D-ring as shown. (Fig. 2-1)

- (b) Install the upper bungee loop over the passenger side hook as shown. (Fig. 2-2)
- (c) Repeat steps 2(a) & 2(b) for the driver side of vehicle.

(d) Completed assembly as shown. (Fig. 2-3)

Accessory Function Checks	
Correct orientation of hooks.	Insure hooks are located in the bottom of the recessed opening after the screw is tightened.
Confirm the net is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.	Make sure the net hooks are attached to the lower D-rings and the loops are attached to the hooks at the top.
Pull Tab orientation.	Make sure the net's plastic pull tab is facing rearward.
Vehicle Function Checks	
Rear cargo door.	Rear cargo door should open and close freely without interference from cargo net.
Tonneau Cover	Tonneau cover should open and close freely without interference from cargo net or hook.
