Procedure

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare the Key Fob.

- (a) Remove the key glove(s) from the packaging.
- (b) Orient the key glove with the cut-outs facing the installer (Fig. 1-1).
- (c) Orient the key fob with the buttons facing the installer (Fig. 1-1).

2. Install the Key Fob into the Key Glove.


(a) Pull the elastic tab (if present) to the side of the key glove (Fig 2-1).

(b) Insert the key fob into the glove, keeping the elastic tab off to the side (Fig 2-2).

(c) Push the key fob completely into the glove (Fig. 2-3).



3. Complete the Installation.

(a) Release the elastic tab (if present) over the top of the key fob and align the cutouts (Fig. 3-1).
