Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.




This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare the Vehicle.







(c) Wipe the cleaned surface with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.

2. Install the Rear Bumper Protector.

(a) Place the part face down on clean flat surface. Remove entire liner (Fig. 2-1).









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
(b) Spray the bumper with wetting agent (Fig. 2-2).



(c) Align the center notch directly below the striker latch opening and the leading edge of the pre-mask along the vertical surface of the bumper, being sure not to roll onto the vertical surface. Do not smooth the part by hand (Fig. 2-3).




(d) Spray the pre-mask with wetting agent. Use the squeegee to make long, smooth overlapping strokes from the center outwards of the horizontal section and begin to wrap over the bumper (Fig. 2-4).



NOTE: Do not use excessive force as it may cause creasing of the protector.

(e) Carefully remove the pre-mask paper 180° against itself prior to squeegeeing the final wrap area (Fig. 2-5).



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- (f) Use the squeegee to make smooth, overlapping downward strokes from the center outwards of the final wrap area on the vertical section (Fig. 2-6).
- (g) Dry off the vehicle with a clean lint free rag.

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Checklist - these points MUST be checked to ensure a q	juality installation.
Check:	Look For:
Accessory Function Checks	
Proper adhesion – Visual	Look for bubbles, loose and lifting edges.
Proper adhesion – Physical	With light pressure rub hand over top of part and if crackling sound occurs, resqueegee. If bubbles cannot be worked out to the nearest edge, replace part.
Proper alignment – Cross-Car	Part must be centered within bumper +/-3mm.
Vehicle Appearance Check	
After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)

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
