**REAR BUMPER PROTECTOR** 

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

- (a) Open the rear lift gate.
- (b) Saturate a clean, lint free cloth with a VDC approved cleaner and scrub the top surface of the rear bumper as shown in Fig. 1-1. Do not allow to air dry. Follow manufacturer's instructions.
  - (c) Wipe the cleaned bumper surface with a clean, dry lint-free cloth.

**NOTE:** Once cleaned, do not contaminate this surface by touching it with bare hands.

#### 2. Install the Bumper Protector.

- (a) The parts and vehicle temperature must be between 15°C and 43°C (65°F and 109°F).
  - (b) Remove tape liner 1 from the center piece of tape (Fig. 2-1).
- (c) Position the bumper protector at the edge of the bumper and align the center arrow to the striker latch, then the profile of the part to the profile of the bumper (Fig. 2-2).







(d) Ensure the spacing is the same at both ends and tack down the centre piece of tape (Fig. 2-2 & Fig. 2-3).

- (e) Peel back tape liner 2 50mm to 75mm (2 to 3 inches). Ensure the spacing is the same and consistent in the corners, then tack the exposed tape down (Fig. 2-4).
- **NOTE:** Liner 2 can be started at either end of the part or used if the liner breaks.
  - (f) Pull tape liner 2 off while holding the part in position along the part length. Ensure the spacing is the same at both ends and is consistent in the corners (Fig. 2-4).
  - (g) Press down firmly on the bumper protector along the tape lengths to ensure complete adhesion to the bumper.

# **NOTE:** Do not use a roller. It will damage the part!

(h) Remove the protective film from the stainless steel surface and discard.

Look For:	
The bumper protector should be visually centered left to right, centered to the strike latch	
The front edge of the bumper protector should appear visually parallel to the front edge of the vehicle bumper	
The spacing gap should not exceed 1.25 mm around the perimeter of the part	
No gap is allowed between the tape and the bumper	
Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
