## 1. Prepare the Vehicle.

(a) Open the package and check the part for damage and kit contents.
(b) Open the trunk lid and remove any stored items and debris from the trunk area.
(c) Place vehicle protection over the trunk opening and rear bumper.

## 2. Install the Cargo Tray.

(a) Place the Cargo Tray in the trunk area with the logo towards the rear of the vehicle and facing up (Fig. 2-1).
(b) Grasp the tray by the sides and fold it up and inward sufficiently to slide it into the rear compartment (Fig. 2-2).
(c) After installing the tray, ensure all of the edges are pushed down against the floor.

## 3. Complete the Installation.

(a) Remove the vehicle protection.
(b) Close the trunk lid.
