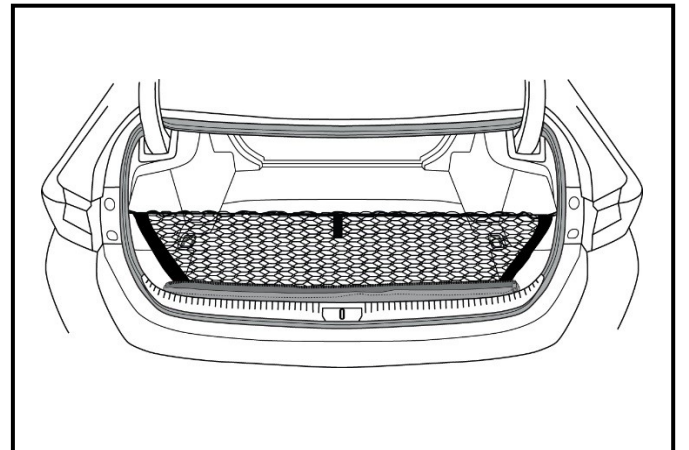
 **OPERATOR SAFETY:** Use caution to avoid risk of injury.

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

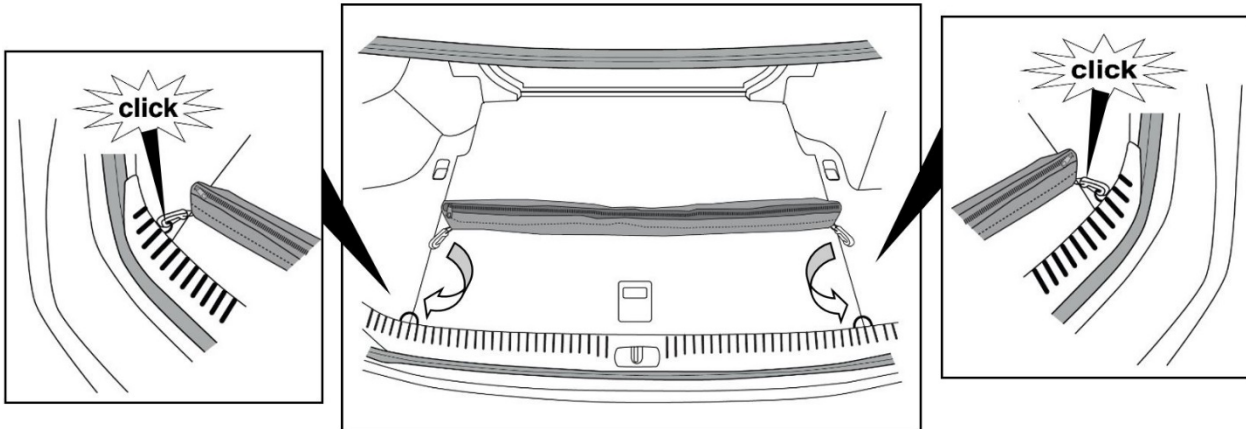

This document covers such items as:-

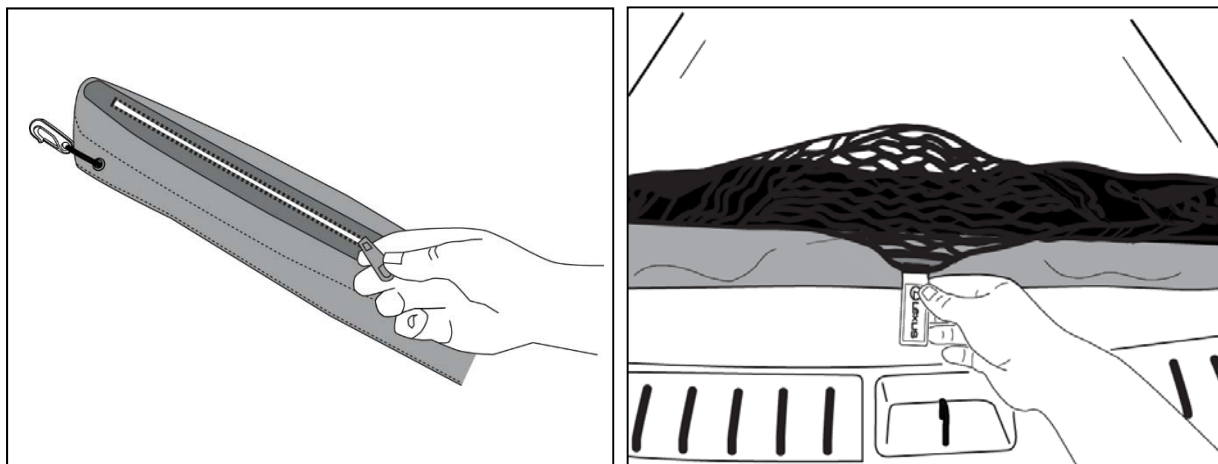
- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).

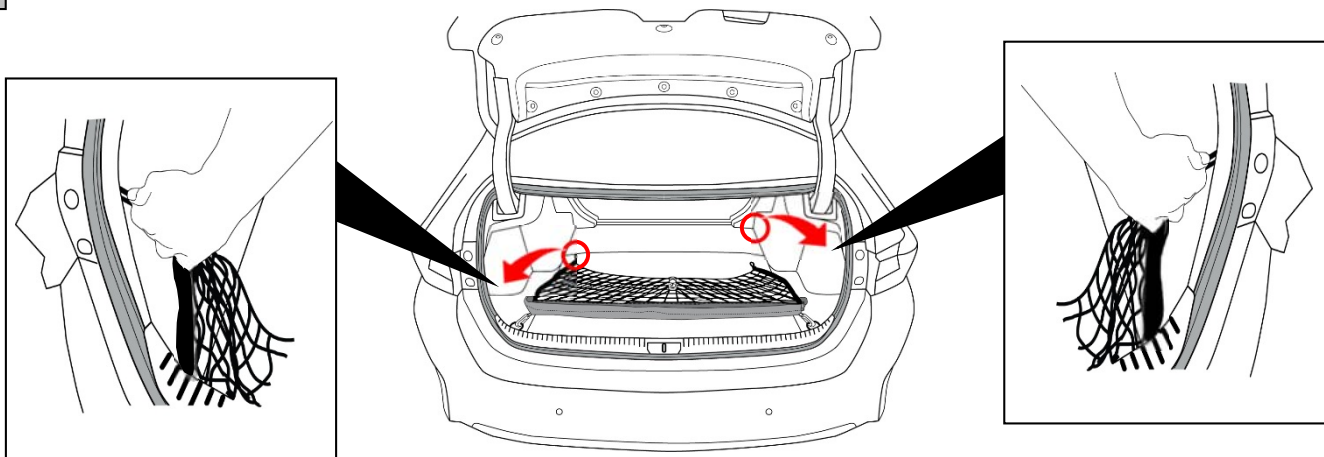

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

<u>Check:</u>	<u>Look For:</u>
<p><u>Accessory Function Checks</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Confirm that the net is attached properly to the anchor points in the vehicle.</p>	<p>Confirm pull tab is facing forward toward the rear of the vehicle.</p> <p>Confirm all clips are properly attached to the D-rings of the vehicle.</p>
<p><u>Vehicle Function Checks</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Vehicle trunk operation</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Confirm vehicle trunk opens and closes without interference from the cargo net.</p>
<p><u>Vehicle Appearance Check</u></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.</p>	<p>Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process.</p> <p>(For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)</p>
