








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










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







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Check:	Look For:
Accessory Function Checks	
Proper adhesion – Visual	Look for bubbles, loose and lifting edges.
Proper adhesion – Physical	With light pressure rub hand over top of part and if crackling sound occurs, resqueegee. If bubbles cannot be worked out to the nearest edge, replace part.
Proper alignment – Cross-Car	Part must be centered within bumper +/-1 mm.
Vehicle Appearance Check	
After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process.
