





1. Install Hardware.

- (a) Open rear hatch door.
- Apply vehicle protection (blanket) to rear sill and fascia.
- (b) Set drill stop to 5mm (Fig. 1-1).
 - (c) Apply strip of masking tape as protection to right side lower rear trim panel (Fig. 1-2).
- (d) Mark drilling location as shown.
 - (1) 145mm (5.7") down from top of lower trim panel.
 - (2) 38mm (1.5") in from rear edge of lower trim panel.
- (e) Center punch the panel at drilling location.
- (f) Drill a 6.35mm (¹/₄") hole into the plastic trim panel as shown (Fig. 1-2).
 - (1) Remove masking tape from panel.
 - (2) Vacuum any remaining drill chips from the vehicle interior.
- (g) Using the panel clip removal tool, carefully pry back the interior panel (Fig. 1-3).


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




- (i) Attach and tighten the T-anchor (Fig. 1-5).
 - (1) Tighten T-anchor, and endure it is vertical.
- (j) Securely reposition the panel.
- (k) Repeat steps 1. (a) through 1. (k) for the other side of the vehicle.

2. Attach Cargo Net.





- (a) Attach the cargo net to the T-anchors at the top and the D-rings at the bottom as shown (Fig. 2-1).
 - (1) Make sure handle on net faces toward the outside of the vehicle.
- (b) Repeat step 2. (a) for the other side of the vehicle.
- (c) Confirm completed assembly.
