






1. Install the Cargo Net.

(a) Open the trunk and locate the upper anchor point on the driver's side of the vehicle (Fig. 1-1).




(b) Attach the top bungee loop to the upper anchor as shown in Fig. 1-2.



(c) Locate the lower anchor point on the driver's side of the vehicle (Fig. 1-3).


