






1. Install the Cargo Net.

(a) Open the trunk and locate the anchor locations on the passenger side of the vehicle (Fig. 1-1).




(b) Attach the loop at the top of the net to the vehicle anchor (Fig. 1-2).



- (c) Attach the hook at the bottom of the net to the vehicle D-ring (Fig. 1-3).
- (d) Repeat Steps 1(a) through 1(c) on the driver side of the vehicle.
