

Procedure

- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).



1. Prepare the Vehicle.

- (a) Open the trunk.
- (b) Place vehicle protection over the rear bumper and trunk deck.

2. Install the First Aid Kit.

- (a) Remove the First Aid Kit from the polybag.
- (b) Locate the strapping on the right side of the trunk deck.
- (c) Loosen the strap latch.
- (d) Insert the First Aid Kit beneath the strapping.
- (e) Tighten the strap; ensure the latch is snug against the kit (Fig. 2-1).
- (f) Remove the vehicle protection.
- (g) Close the trunk.
