Procedure

Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.


This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare the Vehicle.

(a) Open the trunk.

 (b) Place vehicle protection over the rear bumper and trunk deck.

2. Install the First Aid Kit.

(a) Remove the First Aid Kit from the polybag.

(b) Locate the strapping on the right side of the trunk deck.

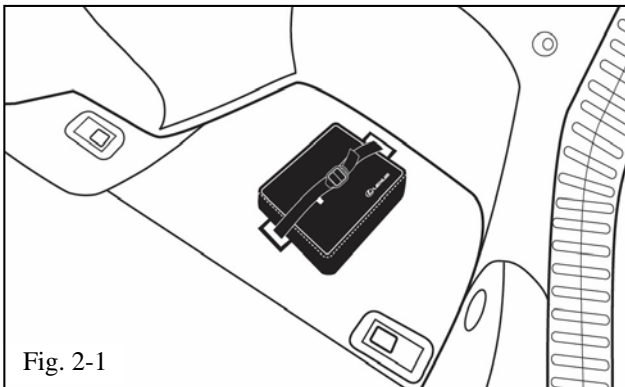
(c) Loosen the strap latch.

(d) Insert the First Aid Kit beneath the strapping.

(e) Tighten the strap; ensure the latch is snug against the kit (Fig. 2-1).

(f) Remove the vehicle protection.

(g) Close the trunk.
